










Frequency of axillary dissection for patients with 1–2 sentinel lymph node-positive



Regional nodal irradiation in patients who did not undergo axillary dissection.




Target volume for regional nodal irradiation



Conclusions:

- Omission of surgery is an ingroing trend
- Due to low-level evidence, there is lack of homogeineity in the prescription of Radiation Therapy.
